

## PUBLISHING AGREEMENT

*Canadian Literature* ("CL") obtains and owns copyright on all of its contents. To clarify the rights of the authors and CL and thus insure the protection of both, CL requires that authors formally assign all rights to CL before an article is published.

In consideration of the fact that CL undertakes to publish my article (including the abstract) of: <<ArticleTitle>> (#<<ArticleSubmissionNumDisplay>>) (The "Work") by <<AuthorsConcat>> (the "Author") published in issue no. <<PublishedInIssue>> (provisional) (the "Work").

1. I represent and warrant that I own and have not assigned elsewhere all rights to the Work.
2. I represent and warrant that I have obtained written permission to use any previously copyrighted material that may be included in the Work, and that falls outside accepted conventions of fair use (fair dealing).
3. I hereby assign and transfer to CL all rights in and to the Work, including the worldwide copyright, translation rights, and the right to grant permission to reprint the Work.
4. Without limiting the generality of Article 3, CL may use the Work in any future publication under its auspices, including electronic and/or new media.
5. The Author may use all or part of the Work for educational or research purposes, or in a work under his/her exclusive authorship or editorship subject only to suitable acknowledgment of its first publication in CL.
6. CL agrees to notify the Author of requests to reprint wherever possible with the exception of requests from educational institutions for copies for classroom use. It is the Author's responsibility to inform CL of any address changes.
7. CL may make minor cuts and emendations without consultation.
8. Upon publication, the Authors will be provided with a copy of their material as it appears in the CL.
